Art should therefore take place in these Zug buildings, with the founders of the Theater- und Musikgesellschaft Zug originally calling for *art of stage and sound*. Our programme is brimming with art, and is as rich as it is varied.

Like the people of Zug itself, art comes from the most diverse of cultures, and the artists express this in their own respective styles and languages, from jazz to fado, dialect to operatic pop, comedy to spoken language theatre, German or English, barefoot or in pointe shoes, from the East or the Western world. Legends from the USA play Russian compositions, while youngsters set the tone as Philip Glass rubs shoulders with Tchaikovsky. Premieres and established classics will be danced, sung and played. The programmes stretches across cultural and geographic lines as well as spanning the generations, both on the stage and in the audience. We have a new concert format, with the only target audience recommendation being that it is "ageless".

We will also have the opportunity to face ourselves on stage, in the most literal sense of the word, as at the end of the season, 100% of the canton will be treading the boards, represented by 100 inhabitants of Zug.
